With my knowledge on React and a few years of experience on frontend I was asked to join Homyspace and bring all I knew to a young startup with a small frontend team trying to find its product-market-fit with this tech.

Here I helped develop the core internal CRM used by other departments as well as a few MVPs using agile methodologies like SCRUM.

A time came when we weren't developing projects quickly enough for a startup that was still trying to find its product-market-fit. So, a refactor was put on the table and with the arrival of new teammates that had experience on it we decided that was the solution we needed to get on track again and achieve our goals.

The team had a thrilling ride, **hitting profitability, boosting our EBITDA 9x**, cutting our **CAC payback period by a quarter**, and celebrating plenty of other wins along the journey.

For me personally it is the discovery of Ruby on Rails as the tool that allows you to quickly build the foundations you need to create the solutions you are trying to solve.
